

Board Advisor Website Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to Board Advisor, LLC (“Board Advisor”). Please read this privacy notice carefully as it contains important information on who we are, how and why we collect, store, use, and share personal information, your rights in relation to your personal information and on how to contact us and supervisory authorities in the event you have a complaint.

By using our website, www.boardadvisor.net you signify your consent to the terms of our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with any terms of this Privacy Policy, please do not use this site or submit any personal information to us.

1. Who We Are

Board Advisor, operating at www.boardadvisor.net collects, uses and is responsible for certain personal information about you.

2. Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act

This website and any products and services offered herein are not intended for persons under the age of 13. Board Advisor does not knowingly collect information from anyone under 13 years of age. Board Advisor prohibits children under the age of 13 from using all interactive portions of this website, including leaving any comments, filling out forms, or otherwise submitting information. Board Advisor will not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under 13. If Board Advisor learns it has any information or content from anyone under the age of 13, it will delete that information.

The Personal Information We Collect and Use

a. *Information Collected by Us*

Board Advisor may collect, use, and is responsible for certain personal information that you provide when you voluntarily when you sign up for email updates on our new white papers, books, purchase an on-line workshop, eBook or AudioBook, register for a webinar or individual workshop or otherwise contact Board Advisor via an online form or e-mail. The information collected may include your name, e-mail, address, phone number, and/or billing information. You are not required to provide any personally identifiable information to merely access or visit this website.

Board Advisor may collect domain information, your numerical IP address, the type of browser you use, which pages you view, and the files you request. We may also use “cookies” (small files saved on your hard drive by your web browser) to analyze website performance, track user patterns, save information from your previous visits and customize your experience. If your browser sends a "Do Not Track" signal, only a generic cookie will be placed on your device while the website is accessed.

We will ask for your consent to allow us to use cookies. Board Advisor or its third-party vendors may collect nonpersonal information through the use of these technologies. Nonpersonal information might include the browser you use, the type of computer you use and technical information about your means of connection to this website such as the operating systems and the Internet service providers utilized and other similar information. Board Advisor’s systems may also automatically gather information about the areas you visit and search terms you use on this website and about the links you may select from within this website to other areas of the Internet.

If you are located in the European Economic Area (“EEA”), we are regulated under the General Data Protection Regulation which applies across the European Union and we are responsible as controller of that personal information for the purposes of those laws.

If you are located in the United Kingdom (“UK”), we are regulated under UK data regulations known as “UK GDPR.”

b. *How we use your personal information*

Board Advisor collects such information in order to send e-mails, reply to enquiries, determine possible topics for webinars, books and workshops, fulfill orders, deliver services and products, complete customer transactions, and improve website performance and customer service.

c. *Who We Share Your Personal Information With*

Board Advisor respects your privacy and will never sell, trade or transfer your personally identifiable information to third parties (beyond what is necessary for fulfilling a customer transaction or for the basic functionality of an online service) without your consent.

We do, however, share your name, email address and other address details with our third-party credit card processors and our Learning Management System host so that they can fulfill purchases. This data sharing enables them to process your payment for goods and services you have ordered, deliver digital products (on-line workshops, video streaming, eBooks and AudioBooks) to you and register you for on-line webinars. Those third-party recipients are based outside the European Economic Area or the UK— for further information including on how we safeguard your personal data when this occurs, see Transfer of your information out of the EEA, UK below.

Board Advisor may release personal information to enforce its Website Terms and Conditions of Use, other Terms and Conditions, manage its business, protect users or the general public, or to otherwise comply with legal obligations.

If you give Board Advisor your permission, it may also use personal identification information for internal or external marketing and promotional purposes.

On occasion, Board Advisor may collect personal identification information from you in connection with new intellectual capital, white papers, books, workshops, special offers, events or promotions. Board Advisor will share such information with necessary third parties for the purpose of carrying out the event, special offer or promotion. We will ask for your consent to such disclosure and use of such information, prior to your participation in the special offer, event or promotion.

We reserve the right to transfer personal information in the event that we merge with or are acquired by a third party. We also may disclose your personal information for any other purpose permitted by law or to which you consent.

We will not share your personal information with any other third party.

d. *Whether Information Has to Be Provided by You and Why*

The provision of your name, email address is required from you to enable us to provide you with email updates, respond to your enquiries and inform you about new white papers, other intellectual capital and events. The provision of your general delivery address may be required to ascertain your location for the purposes of sales tax calculations that may be applicable to the purchase of on-line courses, eBooks or AudioBooks. We do not require you to provide any personal data in order to access the public areas of our website. We will inform you when we collect it whether you are required to provide the information to us.

e. *How Long Your Personal Information Will Be Kept*

We will hold all non-client personal information - name, email address and contact details - for 6 years.

f. *Reasons We Can Collect and Use Your Personal Information*

Board Advisor collects and uses your personal to send e-mails, reply to enquiries, fulfill orders, deliver services and products, complete customer transactions, and improve website performance and customer service.

4. Use and Transfer of Your Information Out of the EEA, UK

This website is operated in the United States and third parties with whom we might share your personal information as explained above are also located in the United States. If you are located in the EEA, the UK, or elsewhere outside of the United States, please be aware that **any information you provide will be transferred to the United States**. By using this website, participating in any of its services and/or providing your information, you consent to this transfer.

These countries do not have the same data protection laws as the EEA or UK. 5. Your Rights

- Otherwise restrict our processing of your personal information in certain circumstances
